POSITION SUMMARY

Elder Rights Engagement Project - The Project Coordinator is responsible to travel to 3 Northwestern Ontario First Nation Communities to deliver and facilitate workshops.

The Project Coordinator is responsible for developing culturally appropriate resource materials which includes developing the workshop. Project activities include: promoting the project, providing awareness of Elder rights and Elder Abuse. To invite community elders for a focus group workshop and, working with community contacts, organize a Breakfast with the Elders event.

This position will be based in Sioux Lookout ON, serving communities within the Equay-wuk (Women's Group) catchment area. Approximately 15 hours/week and more during workshop weeks. Pay is \$25hr. Position is from June - September 2018 (12 weeks).

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Appropriate educational qualifications to manage the tasks and responsibilities of the position;
- 2. Must be willing and able to travel to Northwestern Ontario First Nation communities;
- 3. Demonstrated experience and skills in working with First Nation people, especially Elders;
- 4. Cross-cultural awareness and sensitivity to First Nation issues and values;
- 5. Able to produce culturally based resource materials;
- 6. Prepare workshop reports;
- Experience in planning and facilitating workshops;
- 8. Must be self motivated and able to work without supervision;
- 9. Excellent oral and written communication skills in English;
- 10. Must be able to maintain confidentiality;
- 11. Ability to communicate in one or more First Nation dialects of the Sioux Lookout area would be an asset:
- 12. Administrative skills such a computer, electronic communication and report writing.
- 13. Current Criminal Records check with a Vulnerable Persons check.
- 14. Valid Ontario driver's licence would be an asset.
